Bumasz 2010

The biennial BUMASZ International Fair of Construction and Road Building Machines, Vehicles and Equipment will be organized in Poznań on 19-22 January 2010.

The formula of the upcoming exhibition has undergone several changes. "In response to the expectations of industry representatives, we have modified the thematic scope of two concurrent and complementary shows, namely Budma and Bumasz", says Danuta Kubasik, director of products' group. "Starting from the next edition, construction tools and light construction equipment will be showcased annually at Budma. Solutions for geotechnical works and foundation engineering have also been incorporated into Budma's scope", adds Ms Kubasik.

In addition to exhibitors' portfolios presented at the stands, the fair offers a compelling programme of events. Visitors to Bumasz will be particularly interested in the seminar devoted to construction occupational safety, which is scheduled for the first day of the fair. The event will focus on such themes as: occupational risks and their impact on accidents in the construction sector, as well as occupational safety management in construction companies. There will be also a possibility to attend a lecture of an expert on erection and use of scaffolding on small construction sites. The seminar will be organised by the National Labour Inspectorate in cooperation with the Polish Chamber of Commerce for Scaffolding, Institute of Mechanised Construction and Rock Mining, and Międzynarodowe Targi Poznańskie. Other events featured in the programme of the January construction fair will be: Civil Engineering Day, Architecture Day, International Passive Construction Forum, or a seminar devoted to sustainable development in the construction industry. Furthermore, several special projects will be continued, including the Village of Wooden Houses and Budshow, whose leading theme will be "Sustainable housing".

It is the intention of the organisers to make the show a comprehensive presentation of contemporary trends in the broadly understood field of construction, as well as construction and road-building machines, vehicles and equipment. Despite the challenging economic downturn, the exposition can serve as an efficient method of strengthening or improving corporate image in the market, an impulse enabling further development, and an inspiration to find new business ideas. Bumasz is held in conjunction with BUDMA

International Construction Fair, and CBS – Sports Facilities, Amenity Areas, Wellness & Spa, creating additional possibilities for both exhibitors and visitors.
