

Poznań, 5.01.2010 r.

Safe and innovative technologies for the construction industry

Scheduled to begin on 19 January 2010 in Poznań, BUMASZ International Fair of Construction and Road Building Machines, Vehicles and Equipment will last four days.

The exposition will be housed in Pavilions 7, 7A and 8, and in the outdoor exhibition grounds of Międzynarodowe Targi Poznańskie. Organised concurrently with Budma and CBS shows, this platform for exchanging professional construction knowledge will cover an area of almost 60 000 square metres.

Bumasz is an arena for professional business meetings. Visitors will have a chance to explore a particularly rich selection of construction and road building machines, formwork and scaffolding solutions, along with machines and devices for concrete and mortar pre-treatment, transport and handling, as well as concrete compaction. Numerous construction machines will be displayed side by side with state-of-the-art construction vehicles, cranes and transportation equipment. At exhibition stands, detailed information will be provided on new lines of specialised machines and equipment for road construction, improvement and maintenance. Visitors' attention will undoubtedly focus on innovations in the field of machines and equipment for acquisition and processing of raw materials, and production of construction materials. New construction machines will also make their debut at the fair.

Industry-related events, which complement the presentation of offers at exhibitors' stands, are an indispensable part of the show. One of the attractions prepared specifically for Bumasz participants will be a seminar devoted to construction occupational safety, which will take place on 19 January 2010. The discussion will focus on occupational risks and accidents in the building sector, along with issues relating to safety management in construction companies. Moreover, a lecture will be delivered on major problems and opportunities for change in the field of scaffold construction and use on small construction sites. The seminar is organised by the National Labour Inspectorate in cooperation with the Polish Chamber of Commerce for Scaffolding, Institute of Mechanised Construction and Rock Mining, and Międzynarodowe Targi Poznańskie.
